Monthly Scholarship

Factors such as job loss, illness, death, reduced income, or other situations affect a family's ability to pay from time to time. We want to ensure that unforeseen circumstances do not get in the way of your family's continued participation at MSCC.

Award Amount	MSCC'S Monthly Scholarship provides a reduction for one month of families' tuition.
Availability	Families can be awarded up to 3 times per school year.
Application Timeline	MSCC board of directors reviews applications during their meetings on the third Thursday of the month. Scholarships approved at these meetings will be applied to the following month's tuition.

Yearly Scholarship

MSCC values diversity in our program, including economic status. We prioritize a robust scholarship program to ensure that all families have access to enrollment at Mountain Sprouts.

Award Amount	MSCC's yearly scholarship provides a reduction to families' annual tuition rate (applied to each month's invoice).
Application Timeline	The MSCC board of directors reviews applications during their meetings on the third Thursday of the month. Please submit your application for a yearly scholarship as soon as you are able for the desired school year. Tuition assistance may also be granted mid-year for the remainder of the year determined by available funds.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. Tuition Assistance is need-based and is available at the discretion of the Board of Directors, who may choose to limit the amount of tuition assistance based on enrollment levels, the licensed capacity of MSCC, available staffing, and community needs. The number of enrolled students paying reduced rates may change at any time at the discretion of MSCC.
- 2. The MSCC board of directors requests that all families apply for the DCYF subsidy program in addition to tuition assistance.
- 3. MSCC administers the assistance program without discrimination based on race, color, religion, national origin, sexual orientation or family structure. All Tuition Assistance Applications will be handled in a respectful and confidential manner.
- 4. Children must be regularly enrolled to qualify for tuition assistance.
- 5. MSCC does not guarantee that the total amount of scholarship requested will be awarded.
- 6. A negative determination may not be appealed; however, a new application may be submitted anytime.

Child Care Subsidy

MSCC accepts subsidies from the WA State Department of Children, Youth & Families including the Working Connections Child Care and Seasonal Child Care subsidies. Apply directly with DCYF. Once your application has been approved and you select Mountain Sprouts Children's Community as your child care, the subsidy payment will be made directly to MSCC toward your tuition.
